PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 GENERAL

A. The Contractor shall be experienced and qualified to anticipate and meet the safety and health requirements of this project. The Contractor shall require his personnel to observe proper safety and hygienic precautions.

B. The Contractor shall be solely responsible for the storage, usage, handling and application of all hazardous materials encountered or provided in the Contract.

1.02 SAFETY AND HEALTH REGULATIONS

A. The Contractor shall comply with Safety and Health Regulations for Construction, promulgated by the Secretary Standards Act, as set forth in Title 9, C.F.R. Copies of these regulations may be obtained from Labor Building, 14th and Constitution Avenue NW, Washington, DC 20013.

B. The Contractor shall also comply with the provisions of the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Act, as amended, and with all applicable State of California, Department of Industrial Relations, and Construction Safety Orders (Cal-OSHA) requirements.
