SECTION 01710 CLEANING

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 GENERAL

The requirements specified in the Conditions of the Contract form a part of this Section.

1.02 SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.

- A. Standards. Main project shall be in accordance with the following safety and insurance standards and as specified elsewhere:
 - 1. CAL OSHA
 - B. Hazards Control.
 - 1. Store volatile wastes in covered metal containers, and remove from project site daily.
 - 2. Prevent accumulation of wastes which create hazardous conditions.
 - 3. Provide adequate ventilation during use of noxious or volatile substances.
- C. Conduct cleaning and disposal operations to comply with local ordinances and antipollution laws.
 - 1. Do not burn or bury rubbish and waste materials on project site.
 - 2. Do not dispose of volatile wastes, such as mineral spirits, oil or paint thinner, in storm or sanitary drains.
 - 3. Do not dispose of wastes into streams or waterways.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.01MATERIALS.

- A. Use only cleaning materials recommended by manufacturer of surface to be cleaned.
- B. Use cleaning materials only on surfaces recommended by cleaning material manufacturer.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.01 DURING CONSTRUCTION.

- A. Execute cleaning to ensure that building, grounds, and public properties are maintained free from accumulations of waste materials and rubbish.
 - B. Wet down dry materials and rubbish to lay dust and prevent blowing dust.
- C. At weekly intervals during progress of work, clean site and public properties, and dispose of waste materials, debris and rubbish.
 - D. Provide on-site dump containers for collection of waste materials, debris and rubbish.

- E. Remove waste materials, debris and rubbish from site and legally dispose of at public or private dumping areas off Owner's property.
- F. Schedule cleaning operations so that dust and other contaminants resulting from cleaning process will not fall on wet, newly painted surfaces.

3.02.1 FINAL CLEANING.

- A. Employ experienced workman, or professional cleaners, for final cleaning.
- B. Remove grease, dust, dirt, stains, labels, fingerprints, and other foreign materials, from sight-exposed interior and exterior finished surfaces; polish surfaces so designated to shine finish.
- C. Repair, patch and touch up marred surfaces to specified finish to match adjacent surfaces.
 - D. Broom clean paved surfaces, rake clean, other surfaces of grounds.
 - E. Replace air conditioning filters, if units were operated during construction.
- F. Clean ducts, blowers and coils, if air conditioning units were operated without filters during construction.
 - G. Maintain cleaning until project, or portion thereof, is in use by Owner.
